

JEFFERSON SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA ANNOUNCES SEASON CHANGES THROUGH JANUARY 2021

(July 21 , 2020, Wheat Ridge, CO) – In consideration of ongoing health and safety practices related to COVID-19, the Jefferson Symphony Orchestra (JSO) is suspending concert and live-performance activity through January 2021. The Symphony Board of Directors arrived at the decision during their July meeting. “Until it is safe for our valued musicians and audience to gather, Jefferson Symphony Orchestra rehearsals and concerts are on hold. Our immediate priority is the good health and safety of our families and friends,” notes JSO Music Director William Morse.

Jefferson Symphony hopes to resume live performances and ensemble rehearsals beginning next year as conditions permit. “We have no higher priority than keeping both our audiences and our musicians and staff safe from the spread of this disease,” mentions Chairman Jim Everson.
